REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR SOCIAL AND RELOCATION SUPPORT SERVICES FOR THE EACOP PROJECT IN UGANDA - REFERENCE:10006579

TOTAL East Africa Midstream B.V. (COMPANY) Uganda, an Oil and Gas company, requires the services of experienced and reputable companies to provide social and relocation support to households affected by land requirements for the East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) Project.

The EACOP project involves the construction and operation of a buried, cross-border pipeline to transport crude oil from the lake Albert area in Uganda to the eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline will run from Kabaale in Hoima District, Uganda, to Chongoleani, Tanga Region, in Tanzania. The length of the pipeline is 1,443 kilometers (km), of which 296 km will be in Uganda.

The section of the pipeline in Uganda will traverse ten (10) Districts, comprising Hoima, Kikuube, Kakumiro, Kyankwanzi, Mubende, Gomba, Sembabule, Lwengo, Rakai and Kyotera

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF WORK:

The EACOP Project has prepared a Resettlement Action Plan (RAP) which describes the process of land acquisition, compensation, transitional and relocation support and livelihood restoration for affected persons along the pipeline route.

COMPANY requires the services of experienced social consulting companies to support and engage with affected households in preparation for and during RAP implementation processes such as compensation payment, relocation, transitional support and livelihood restoration. The potential companies need to be familiar with land acquisition processes, and international standards and requirements.

The scope will require the company to engage with and support affected households along the route of the pipeline across all 10 Districts traversed in Uganda.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Companies expressing their interest are invited to document their request with:

- Proof of current registration to the National Supplier Database for the year 2020-2021;
- Evidence of Company QHSE policy, procedure and process in compliance with applicable National and Industry standards for similar works.
- Experience/performance in similar contracts locally and / or within East Africa, in compliance with national and international standards.
- Key suitably qualified, experienced and registered / accredited lead personnel (in fields such as community engagement, social support, socio-economic surveys, and data management, planning and organization of community engagement events for RAP implementation).
- Staff resource capacity to deliver the required services along the pipeline route in Uganda.
- Proof of financial capacity to deliver the services required
- Proof of registration with the Uganda Revenue Authority and Tax Clearance Certificate for the latest year.
