



EAST AFRICAN CRUDE OIL PIPELINE

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR THE PROVISION OF OFFICE SPACE IN HOIMA, MUBENDE, SEMBABULE AND KYOTERA TO SUPPORT THE EAST AFRICAN CRUDE OIL PROJECT IN UGANDA REFERENCE: 10007162

The EACOP Project involves the construction and operation of a buried, cross-border pipeline to transport crude oil from the Lake Albert area in Uganda to the eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline will run from Kabaale in Hoima District Uganda to Chongoleani, Tanga Region in Tanzania. In Uganda the pipeline will traverse ten (10) districts, comprising Hoima, Kikuube, Kakumira, Kyankwanzi, Mubende, Gomba, Sembabule, Lwengo, Rakai and Kyotera.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF WORK:

TotalEnergies East Africa Midstream B.V. (Company) Uganda requires the services of experienced and reputable Contractor(s) on behalf of the EACOP Project, to provide offices in; Hoima, Mubende, Sembabule and Kyotera districts. Contractor(s) can apply for all or only one of the locations identified above.

Office(s) should be townhouses (with bedrooms) located within:

- The district centre (within a maximum of a one-kilometer radius) or
- Near the District Headquarters (walking distance)

The required house(s) shall include:

- Two (2) office spaces (minimum of 16 m2 each)
- Living room (minimum of 18m2) to be used as a meeting room
- Storage room (at least 10 m2)
- One (1) kitchen area
- Two (2) flush toilets
- Parking space for a minimum of 4 cars
- Fit latrine (if possible)

Houses should have water and electricity supply.

The House(s) shall be furnished with six (6) office desks, one (1) large table, two (2) office cabinets and ten (10) chairs.

House(s) specifications shall provide minimum level of security (appropriate metallic doors and windows, fencing, appropriate lighting outside the building).

Air-conditioning is preferable.

The service shall also include the provision of:

- Security services (24/7)
- Maintenance of the building
- Daily cleaning services
- Back-up generator

Dedicated space for a signpost visible from the street should be included.

If possible, space for a notice board in front of the house could be made available.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Suitably qualified Contractors interested in providing these services shall express their interest and submit the following documentation:

- The proposed building(s) exact location
- The proposed building(s) specifications (blueprint with identification of the electrical plugs location)
- Photos of the building(s) both inside and outside (including parking space)
- Back-up generator specifications (model, capacity)
- Photos of the electrical system (switchboard and plugs)
- Photos of the proposed furniture
- Ventilation system
- Evidence of appropriate Health, Safety, Environment, Security measures and equipment (For example type of doors and windows, description of the fire prevention system)
- Experienced personnel to manage the property
- Good financial solvency to deliver the services
- Commitment to required statutory National Content requirements for oil and gas operations
- Current registration to; or application to be registered to the National Supplier Database

Contractor(s) is expected to consent to a thorough Health, Safety, Security and Environment inspection by TEAM B.V.
