

## REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) SUPPLY OF SPECIALIST UNDERGROUND MAGNETIC LOCATOR EQUIPMENT REFFERENCE NO. 10007416

The East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) project involves the construction and operation of a buried, cross-border pipeline to transport crude oil from the Lake Albert area in Uganda to the eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline will run from Kabaale in Hoima District, Uganda to Chongoleani, Tanga Region, in Tanzania.

## BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THE SERVICES:

TotalEnergies East Africa Midstream B.V. (Company) invites experienced and reputable organizations to express their interest to supply underground magnetic and large loop metal detection locators to the EACOP project in Uganda.

- The supply of large-loop metal detection system with productivity of up to 2.5 ha per day and capable of detecting ferrous and non-ferrous metals and alloys -
  - Must be hand carriable and battery-operated, capable of use on or under water, fitted with a DELAY regulator to exclude the indication of unwanted signals from small metal scrap, designed in a modular concept allowing a cannibalization or component exchange/ interchange without workshop environment or advanced training, have data logger capability.

- Experience in the provision of similar services including client references to whom similar services have been provided to.
- Proof of financial capability to undertake the proposed scope of services
- Proof of registration with the Uganda Revenue Authority and Tax Clearance Certificate for the latest year available.
- Proof of Registration on the National Supplier Database maintained by the Petroleum Authority of Uganda for service providers in the Oil and Gas Sector
- Compliance with the Petroleum Midstream National Content Regulations, 2016.
