

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE PROVISION OF DESIGN, HOSTING AND SUPPORT SERVICES FOR THE EAST AFRICAN CRUDE OIL PIPELINE (EACOP) PROJECT WEBSITE REF. 10006669

TOTAL East Africa Midstream B.V. (Company) Tanzania, an Oil and Gas company, invites experienced and reputable Companies to express their interest in providing designing, hosting and support services for the East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) project website.

The EACOP Project involves the construction and operation of a buried, cross-border pipeline to transport crude oil from the Lake Albert area in Uganda to the eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline will run from Kabaale in Hoima District, Uganda, to Chongoleani, Tanga Region, in Tanzania. The length of the pipeline is 1,443 km, of which 1,147 km will be in Tanzania. The section of the pipeline in Tanzania will traverse eight [8] regions, comprising Kagera, Geita, Shinyanga, Tabora, Singida, Dodoma, Manyara and Tanga. The pipeline will traverse 27 administrative district councils and 231 Villages.
