Purpose and scope of assignment

A Chief Officer is the second in command on a berge, also commonly known as the first officer, he is responsible for supporting the captain in supervising the berge crew.

Job responsibilities

- Inspecting machines for defects.
- Second in command of vessel.
- Primarily responsible to the Captain for assisting in the navigation and maneuvering of the vessel
- Its cleanliness, maintenance, and the assignments of crew in tasks relating thereto.
- Supervises and performs routine shipboard maintenance as required.
- Maintenance of exterior and interior vessel spaces.
- Responsible to the captain for the safety and security of the ship.
- Responsibilities include the crew's welfare and training in areas such as safety, fire fighting, search and rescue.
- Oversees the loading, stowage, securing, unloading of cargoes, updating charts and publication, passage plan.
- Accountable for the care of cargo during the voyage.
- Focuses on duties such as cargo operations, fire and security watches, monitoring communications and the anchor or mooring lines.
- Navigates the ship, safely avoid traffic, and respond to any emergencies that may arise.
- The Chief Mate must also make sure that the vessel is maintained and operated according to the guidelines as they are stated in the Marine Operations Manual.
- Maintenance of all LSA / FFA item, records of LSA / FFA, Inventory of deck stores / publications / equipment manual.
- Should know rope / wire splicing & train crew for same.
- Assist master in complying with Master's review of SMS & SSP.

Job qualification, experience and skills.

• Must be Tanzanian citizen.





- Should have valid Certificate of Competency STCW II/2 as Chief Mate/Chief Officer (Class II).
- Should have valid GMDSS Radio Operator Certificate.
