<p>The East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) project is a major regional infrastructure project (Capex: 4.1 G\$, OPEX:>2.5 G\$ over 25 years) between Uganda and Tanzania coast, opening a new value corridor between the two countries. The project anticipates the mobilization of ~8,000 to 10,000 personnel across the various construction sites.</p> <p>This role functions as specialist advisor and support for the EACOP corporate entity. The Reinstatement Coordinator will work with relevant EACOP teams and external Consultants to complete reinstatement scenarios in sections of natural habitat and critical habitat as defined by the Critical Habitat Assessment's Biodiversity Action Plan. The role will involve evaluation of the tasks that can be completed by the contractors (e.g., topsoil replacement, erosion control) and the tasks to be completed by the EACOP corporate entity (e.g., establishment of nurseries, monitoring requirements) in order to support the development of comprehensive location specific reinstatement plans.</p>
